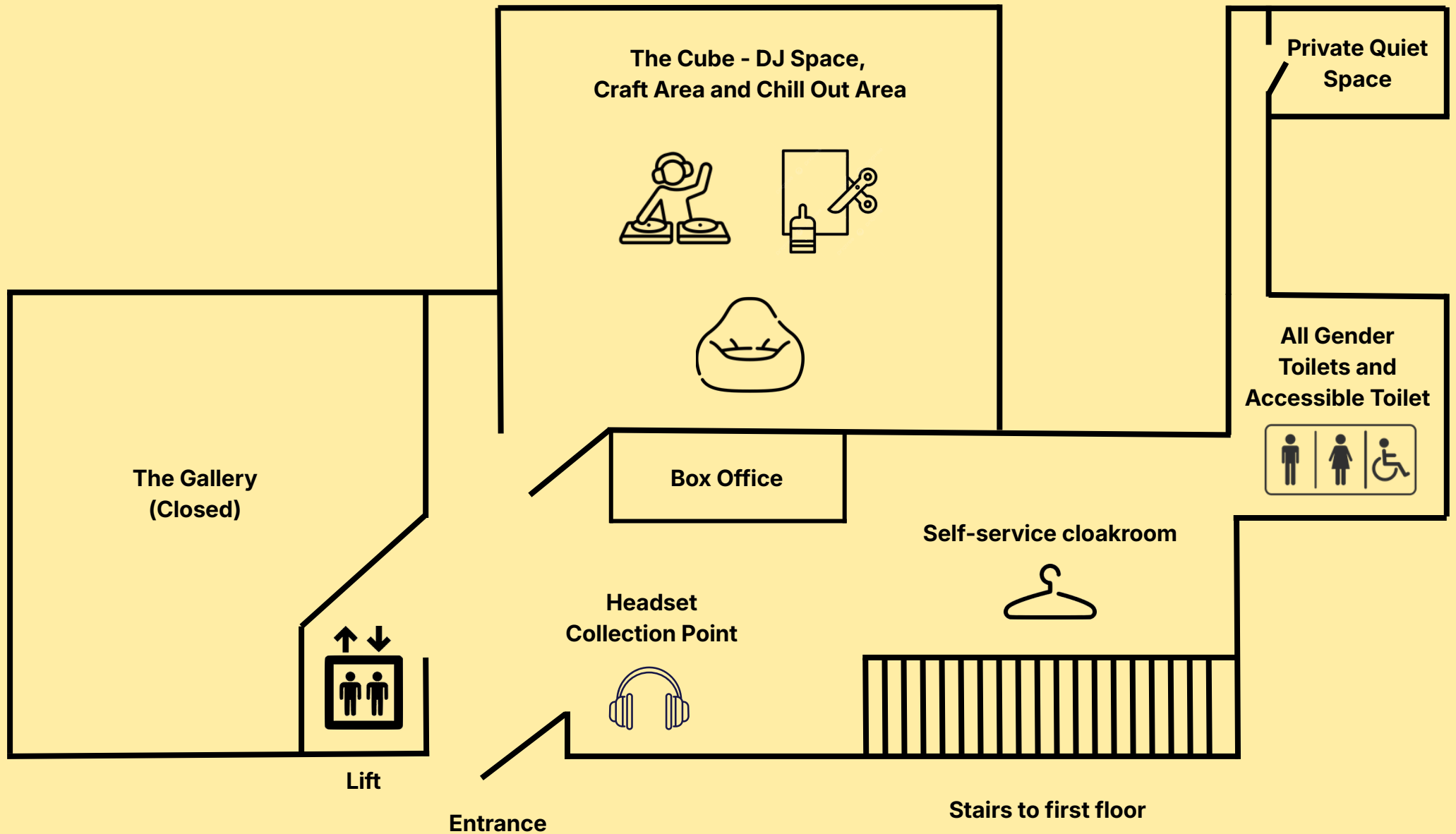

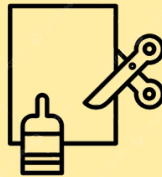
# Page 2 - Ground Floor Map



# Page 3 - Ground Floor Information



- Wireless headphones are provided on arrival.
- Staff will instruct you on how to use the headsets.
- Use the channels to switch between DJs.
- Headphones are optional, and you're welcome to use your own hearing protection.



- A craft area will also be available in The Cube Space.
- Here you can make wearable materials during the event.
- A member of the Wired collective will facilitate this activity



- A self-service cloakroom will be available at the top of the stairs.
- Here you will be able to leave any bags or coats.
- This cloakroom will not be staffed and any items left are the responsibility of their owner.

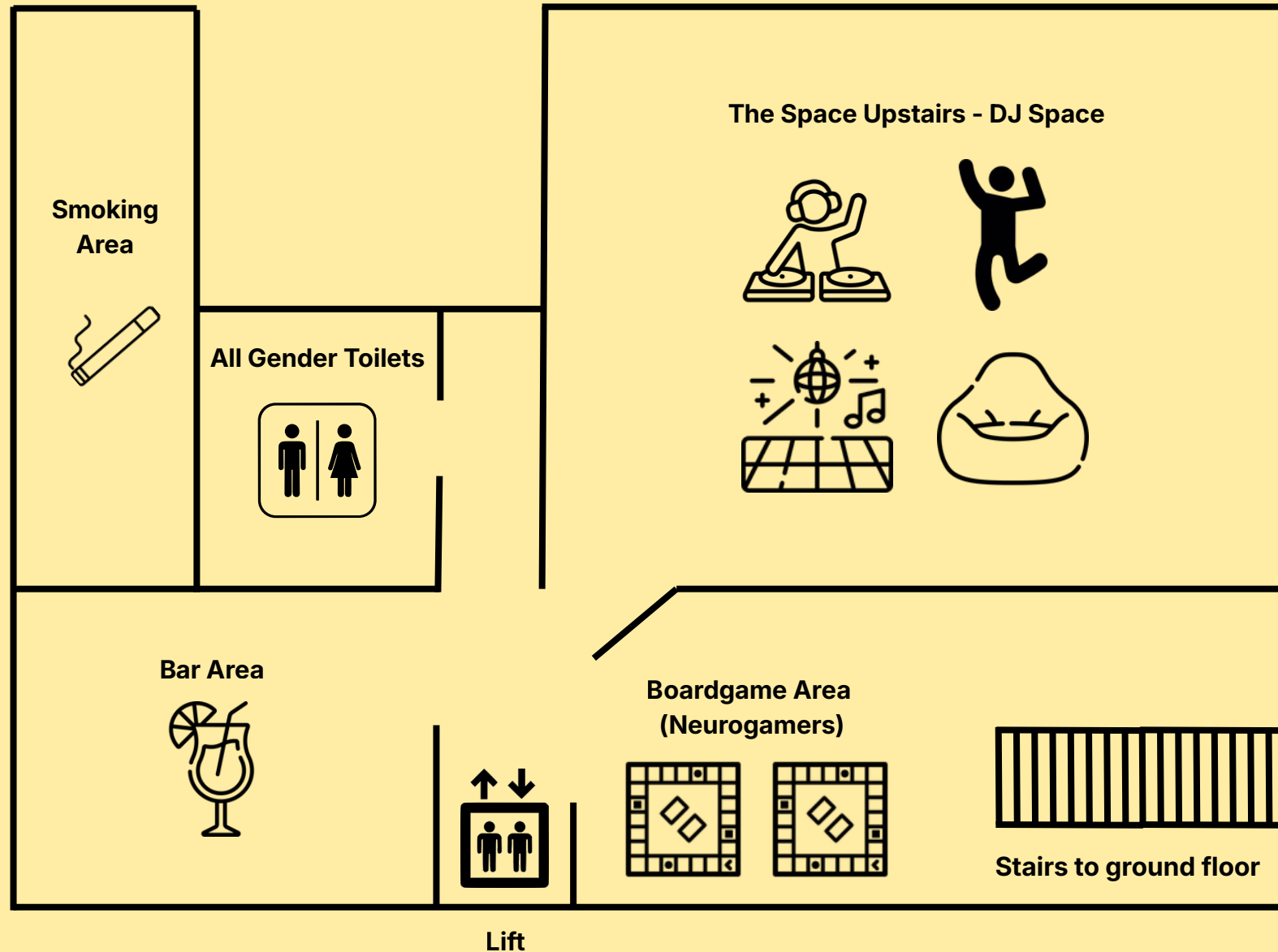


- The DJ set on the ground floor will take place in The Cube from 8.30pm - 11.30pm.
- Each DJ will DJ for one hour each.
- Music will be played through speakers in the spaces at a low volume and through one of the headset channels also.
- Music will be ambient music.



- A chill out space will be located in The Cube space.
- There will be bean bags and other sensory tools located here.
- You can chill out here if you want to.

# Page 4 - First Floor Map



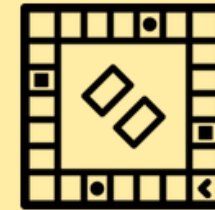
# Page 5 - First Floor Information



- The Space Upstairs is the DJ and dance space.
- Dancing will happen on the stage area in front of the seating.
- There will be various neuro-friendly resources present and some chill out spaces and seating.
- Haze will be present in the space at different times.



- Dancers and hosts will be present in The Space Upstairs.
- They will be responding to the music in different ways.
- You do not need to engage with the dancers if you do not want.



- A board game area will be situated at the top of the stairs.
- This will be facilitated by Neurogamers who are an independent group to Wired.



- The DJ set on the first floor will take place in The Space Upstairs from 8.30pm - 11.30pm.
- Each DJ will DJ for one hour each.
- Music will be played through speakers in the spaces at a low volume and through one of the headset channels also.



- The Bar is located on the First Floor.
- In the bar there will be mid tempo music playing.
- There is also some seating available around the space.
- No drinks are allowed in the DJ or dance spaces.
- There is an outdoor smoking area also available next to the bar.
