ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE

Ireland's all-island dance company makes its highly anticipated debut to open Dublin Dance Festival's 21st Edition with *Chora*, a triple bill of new dance works by acclaimed choreographers Maria Campos and Guy Nader, Liz Roche, and Mufutau Yusuf.

Titled *Chora*, an ancient Greek term referring to space as both a physical place and an abstract idea, this triple bill of new sees Luail's dancers join forces with Irish Chamber Orchestra in a vibrant exchange of music and dance that draws on themes of home, memory, and landscape.

With set and costume design by Katie Davenport and lighting design by Sinéad McKenna, *Chora* sees the dancers and musicians draw on their bodies, instruments, and ultimately, each other. This seamless interplay of movement and sound weaves a powerful expression of connection and the transformative impact of the shared environments we inhabit.

Total running time is 95mins (including a 20min interval).

ABOUT THE COMPANY

Luail Ireland's National Dance Company, established in 2024 with funding from The Arts Council / An Chomhairle Ealaíon has a remit to embody, embed and empower dance across the island of Ireland, and to lead into a future that transforms how we make, know and experience it.

ABOUT THE CREATORS

Liz Roche is an Irish choreographer whose work has been presented internationally at venues such as the Baryshnikov Arts Centre, South Bank Centre, and Powerhouse Brisbane. She has been commissioned by The Abbey Theatre, Dublin Dance Festival, The National Ballet of China, and Scottish Dance Theatre, among others. Liz has also choreographed for opera and theatre companies, including Irish National Opera, Liceu Barcelona, and The Gate. In 2020, she was elected to Aosdána

Maria Campos studied at SEAD in Austria and obtained a BA in Dance from the Amsterdam School of the Arts (MTD) in 2003. She has worked with various companies and independent artists, combining teaching and her own creation.

Guy Nader obtained a BA in Theatre from the Institute of Fine Arts in the Lebanese University in Beirut and a Diploma from Moveo, physical theater school in Barcelona. He was granted the DanceWEB Europe scholarship in 2012.

Mufutau Yusuf is one of Luail's resident choreographers, based between Ireland and Brussels, where he has worked primarily with Belgian choreographer Wim Vandekeybus/Ultima Vez between 2018 and 2024. In Ireland, Mufutau has worked with Irish Modern Dance Theatre, Emma Martin's United Fall and Liz Roche Company. He made his full-length NYC debut with *Òwe* at the Irish Arts Centre, New York in 2022. Mufutau premiered his work *Impasse*, at Dublin Dance Festival 2024, which toured across Ireland and internationally. *Impasse* will tour again later in 2025.
