ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE

Trailblazing choreographer and director of the renowned Tanztheater Wuppertal Pina Bausch, Boris Charmatz brings his dynamic and minimalist solo *SOMNOLE* to DDF's 21st Edition. In this hypnotic performance, Charmatz draws audiences into the dreamlike realm of somnolence – the delicate space between wakefulness and sleep.

Alone on stage and accompanied only by the sound of his own whistling, Charmatz pushes his physicality and stamina to the limit. As familiar melodies emerge, blend and dissolve, we find moments of calm, intensity and humour. His powerful choreography merges slumberous gestures with rapid rhythms, as the body seeks rest while resisting surrender.

A meditative and profound journey, *SOMNOLE* explores the quiet tension between the mind's longing for stillness and its restless motion. With lighting that shifts between shadows and blinding beams, the performance casts a spell of fleeting clarity, offering a poignant reflection on rest, daydreams, and the beauty that lies between.

ABOUT THE CREATOR

Boris Charmatz is a dancer, choreographer, and visionary in contemporary dance. He emerged in 1993 with À *bras-le-corps*, a groundbreaking duet with Dimitri Chamblas. From 2009 to 2018, he led the CCN de Rennes et de Bretagne, transforming it into Musée de la danse, an experimental space redefining the relationship between dance, audiences, and artistic territories. His works, including *Aatt enen tionon* (1996), *enfant* (2011, Festival d'Avignon), and *10000 gestes* (2017), have been performed worldwide and featured in retrospectives at MoMA, Tate Modern, and Festival d'Automne.

Since 2019, he has continued to push the boundaries of dance with his company, Terrain. From 2022 to 2025, he has been director of Tanztheater Wuppertal Pina Bausch, forging a new Franco-German project. Most recently, in 2024, he was named "Artiste Complice" at the 78th Festival d'Avignon.
